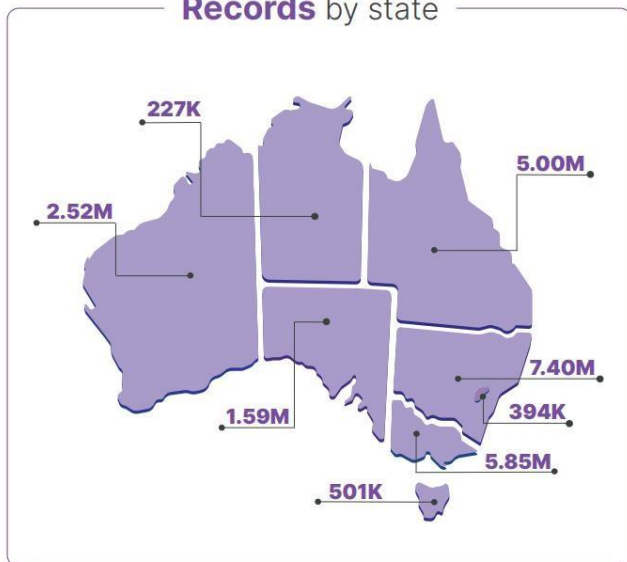

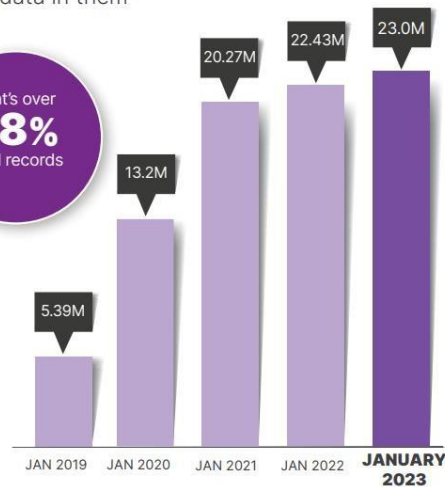


Records by state

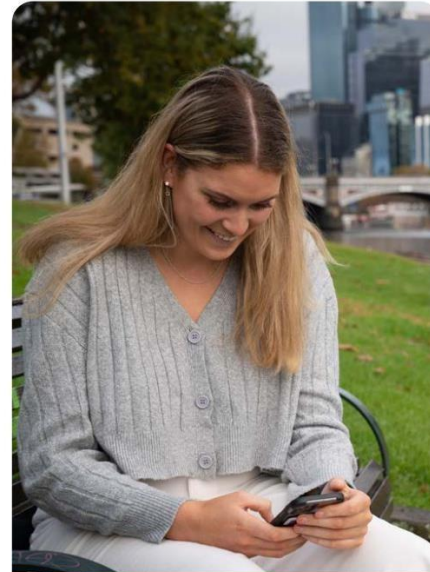

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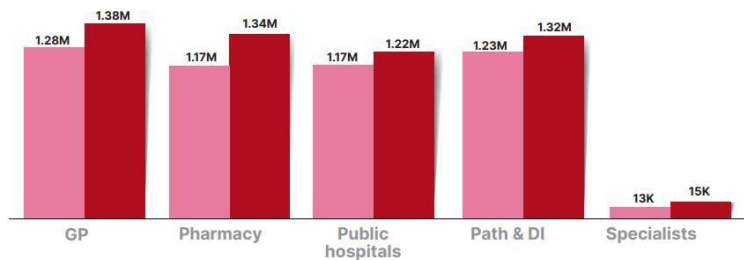

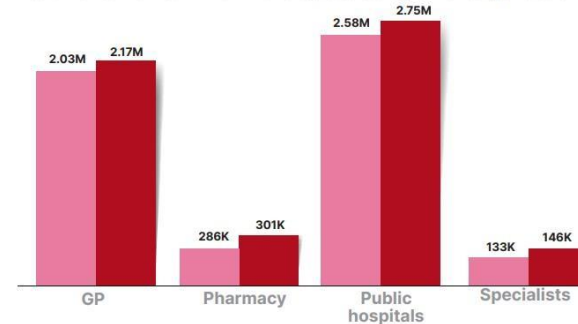

My Health Record – benefits

- Quick and easy access to key health information that has not been received directly
- Less administrative burden gathering patient information
- Saving time and costs associated with sending letters to other healthcare providers
- Improved clinical decision making through access to patient-specific information
- Avoidance of duplicating tests, scans and diagnostics



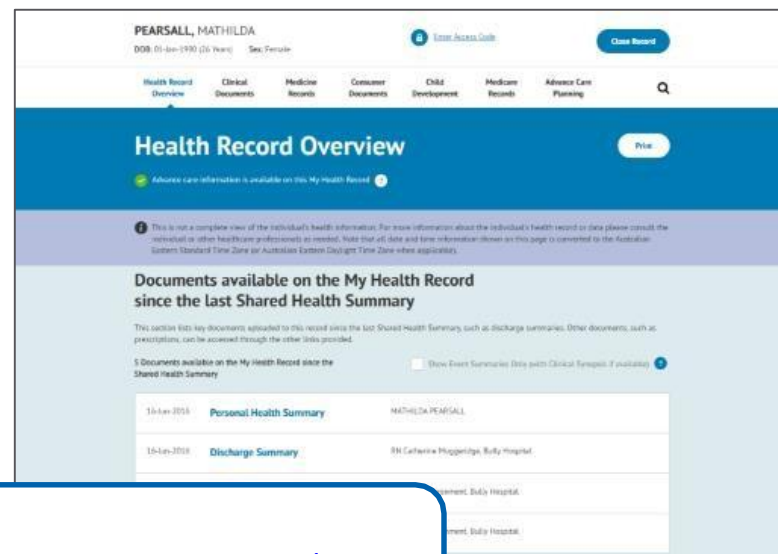

Key features of new My Health Record-enabled practice software

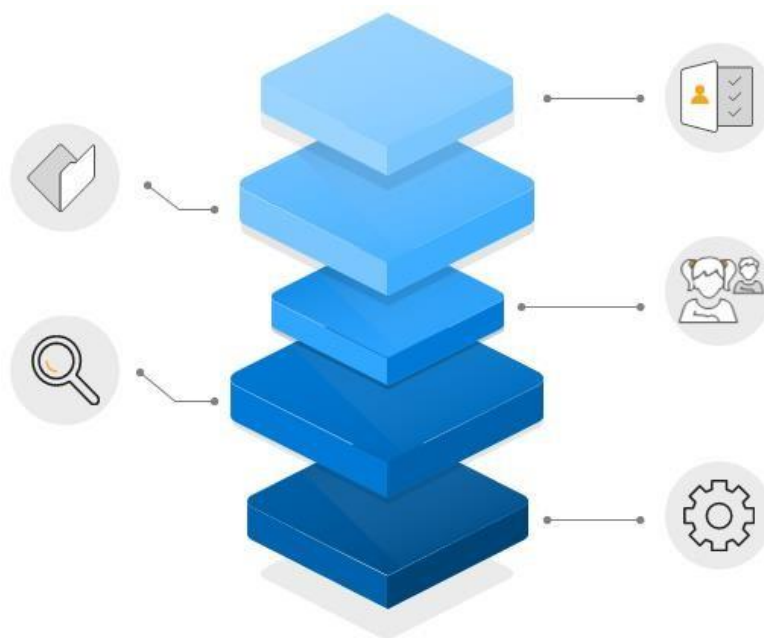
- View important information about patients, including:
 - Hospital discharge summaries
 - Pathology reports
 - Diagnostic Imaging reports
 - Shared Health Summaries
 - Medicines View
- Easily upload a copy of your specialist letter into a patient's My Health Record, without interrupting your normal workflow
- Easily upload a copy of the prescriptions you write to a patient's My Health Record

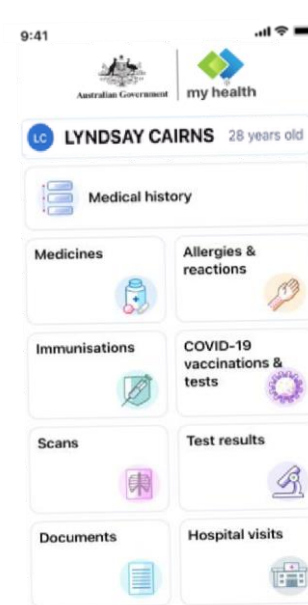


Questions and answers

What is the 'my health' app?

'my health' is an application which can be used by consumers to access key health information in My Health Record.

- The 'my health' app lets consumers download documents from My Health Record onto their mobile device.
- The app also lets consumers share documents that contain their health information with other healthcare providers or organisations.

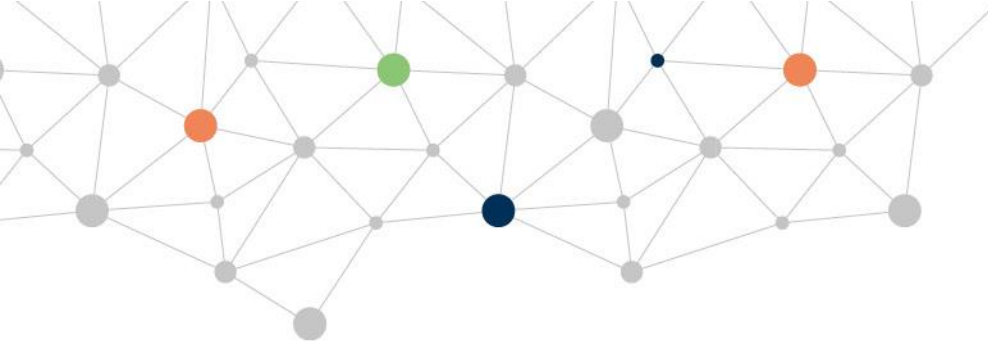

1. Existing Referral Processes

Ideal ————— 20% Room for improvement 80%?

Fax and Email

- Did the fax get through?
- Who picked up that fax or email?
- Is the specialist address still correct?

Info Gaps

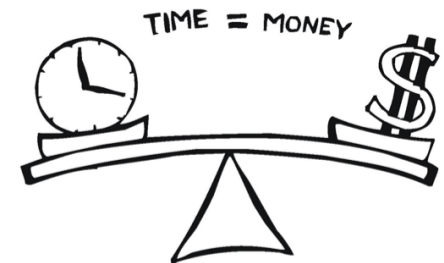
- GP: How do I find & refer to that specialist?
- local address book?
 - hospital directories?
 - sending by fax or electronic - which provider?
 - plus multitude of out of date referral templates...

Specialist reception:

- How do I find that patient referral?
- easier to ask patient to get the GP to re-fax?
- frustrated patients and GPs??

Inefficiency

- GP and specialist rooms printing & scanning referrals, retyping, following up....

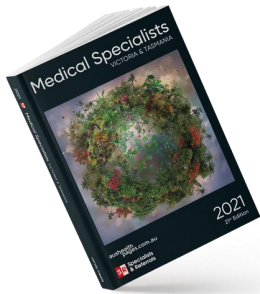

2. Collaborating to make e-Referrals Easy



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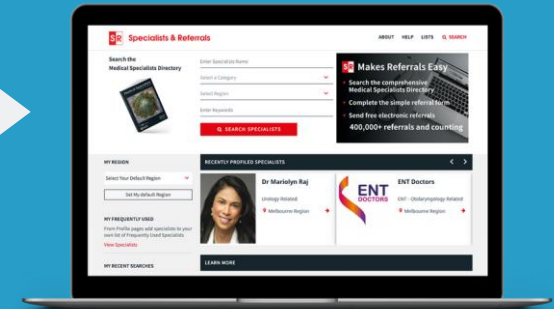

HealthLink:

Secure Messaging Service &
SmartForms



- Family business, began NZ Directories 1991
- Launched Australian Directories 2000
- Directories curated - all entries validated
- All private Specialists included, some pay for premium entries
- Distributed free to all GPs and Specialists - VIC, TAS, NSW, ACT
- Launched SR in NZ 2015 - now main method of GPs referring to Private Specialists
- SR is live now for all GPs and Specialists with HealthLink - no install required
- Experienced in providing hands-on SR support to GPs and Specialists to make e-referrals easy



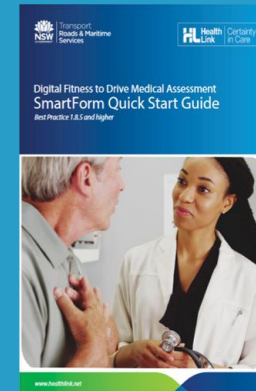
SR is the online version of the Medical Specialist Directories

SR is integrated in Practice software:

- Genie
- Medical Director
- Best Practice and more



- HealthLink provides a Secure Messaging Service widely used by most General Practices and Specialists
- Specialists with a HealthLink EDI can receive SR e-referrals
- Free for Specialists to register for an EDI address
- Setup Integrated into Practice Software or Portal Account (web browser access)
- Free for all GPs and Specialists to Send & Receive SR e-referrals



HealthLink SmartForms give GPs a familiar workflow for referrals to:

- Hospitals
- My Aged Care
- Fitness to Drive
- SR Specialists & Referrals

Sending SmartForms is becoming an everyday activity for GPs.

3. Why Referrals ?

Ideal  90% Collaboration is key

For Patients

- GP sends referral efficiently - no wasted time
- Quality clinical handover
- Personal health info protected
- Patient not asked for referral to be re-faxed

For GPs

- Only need to look in one up-to-date directory for all specialists
- One easy template for all referrals - electronic and manual
- Less printing & faxing
- Meet GP accreditation requirements for clinical handover
- Meets e-refer criteria for Practice Incentive Payments
- Can provide patient with choice and info on specialists

For Specialists

- Less printing, scanning and retyping...
- Easier to find patient referrals
- More timely patient care
- Improved referral quality
- Easy to update contact details for GPs sending referrals
- Plus more NEW benefits...



4. How to be setup for e-Referrals

- Are you already live?



If you have HealthLink & Genie

- You are live for e-referrals
- Do your staff check "Incoming Letters" in Genie?
- View your details in SR and let us know if you have updates
- Contact us for any support

If you have HealthLink & Other Software

- If your software is compatible with HealthLink SmartForms then you are live for e-referrals
- Contact us for any support and training on your referrals

If you don't have HealthLink

- Register for a free HealthLink EDI
- If you are on compatible software then HealthLink will remote in to setup your messaging
- If you are not on compatible software then you can be setup with a "Portal" account
- Once your HealthLink account is setup we will turn on your SR e-referrals.

- If you have particular GP practices that you would like to see shift from faxes to e-referrals, let us know and we can contact them and offer training

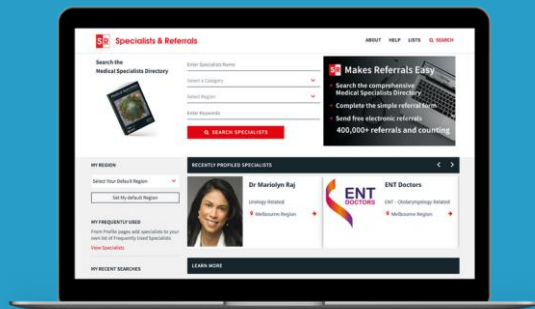
Let us know if you have updates
