# GP Aged Care Connect and MyMedicare

You may have heard about a new voluntary patient registration system called MyMedicare.

The Federal Government introduced this new system to provide more incentives for general practice to care for people living in residential aged care homes.

Murray PHN's GP Aged Care Connect service has been established to support these initiatives, so new and existing residents can access regular visits, care planning and health assessment services that are available under the incentives.

If you live in a residential aged care home, you can register for MyMedicare by completing a registration form provided by your GP or through your Medicare Online Account. *You don't need to physically attend a practice to complete your registration.*
