

INTRODUCTION TO ABORIGINAL CULTURAL SAFETY

This training is facilitated by the Victorian Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisation (VACCHO). It offers foundational knowledge and awareness of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, identities and cultures, while also exploring the basics of cultural safety and simple ways to put it into practice. VACCHO's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander facilitators enhance participant experience and learning by sharing cultural knowledge and lived experience in a safe learning environment where questions are encouraged and welcome.

Participation requires people to keep their cameras on for the entire session, and because it is a five-hour interactive workshop, finding a quiet room or space from which to join is strongly recommended.
