Preparation

Preparing Patients for a Disaster

This pathway is about preparing patients for disaster to increase patient safety and care.

Preparing a General Practice for a Disaster

This pathway is about preparing general practices for disaster, providing information about business continuity and ability to provide essential healthcare services.

Management

General Practice Management During a Disaster

This page is for use by general practices and general practitioners during a disaster.

Rural Community Support During Adversity

This page is about options for patients requiring referral for support services arising from disasters or adverse weather events e.g., bushfires, floods, droughts

Smoke Inhalation

This pathway is about the health effects of smoke from house fires, industrial fires, and bushfires.

Rural Health Assessment in Adversity

This pathway is for patients presenting with potential mental health issues arising from disasters or adverse weather events e.g., bushfires

Disaster or Adverse Weather Event - Mental Health

This pathway is for patients presenting with mental health issues arising from disasters or adverse weather events.

Heat-related Illness

This pathway is about heat-related illness.

Mosquito-borne Diseases in Victoria

This pathway is about the more commonly encountered mosquito-borne disease in Victoria.

Zoonoses

This pathway is about the more commonly encountered agricultural zoonoses in Victoria.

Chemical Exposure and Toxicity

This pathway is about the management of acute and chronic effects of chemical exposure and toxicity, in particular agricultural chemicals and occupational or on-farm exposure.

Snake Bite

This pathway is about the more commonly encountered snake bites in Victoria.

This pathway is for patients presenting with health problems arising from disasters or adverse weather events.
